General debate on the role of South-South cooperation and the implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development: challenges and opportunities [item 8] (continued)

The Conference continued its consideration of agenda item 8.

The Conference heard statements by Ms. Teresa Ribeiro, Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs and Cooperation of Portugal; Mr. David Cooney, State Secretary and Special Envoy of Ireland to the Conference; and Mr. Mohcine Jazouli, Minister delegate to the Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation, in charge of African Cooperation of Morocco.

Statements were made by the representatives of Thailand (on behalf of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations and in national capacity), Israel, Djibouti, Tunisia, India, Eritrea, the Holy See, Panama, Jamaica, Japan, Burundi, El Salvador, Kuwait, Algeria, the Russian Federation, Antigua and Barbuda, the Republic of Korea, Albania, Bahrain, the United Arab Emirates, Honduras, Pakistan, Libya, Canada, Burkina Faso, Nicaragua and the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela.
